Dear Senior Pastor Search Committee,

My desire for many years has been to one day pastor this church full-time for as long as God would allow. I believe God has given me the longing to enter this ministry. I pray that I have not just lived transactionally with you but that I have shared my very self with you as a testimony that my words about Christ are genuine. I hope you have seen my love for you grow, as I have been with you the past thirteen years and trust God in this.

So, I submit my application with joy in the hope of Christ, the power of God, who does immeasurably more than I can imagine. Let His will be done. I have deep affection for you all. If you wish to consider me further, I will seek to answer any questions with integrity whether they prove or disprove my qualifications.
